Rules of Conduct

1. Follow the chain of command at all times
2. No hazing (sexual or verbal) or horseplay will be permitted.
3. No fraternizing between male and female cadets.
4. No alcoholic beverages.
5. No weapons.
6. No boom boxes.
7. No smoking in the CAP compound.
8. Personnel will remain at their assigned posts until relieved.
9. Personnel will report to their duty assignment PROMPTLY.
10. Cadets will wear the prescribed CAP uniform of the day while on duty.
11. Cadets will remain in their bunks after "lights out".
12. Personnel will adhere to proper standards of person hygiene (daily showers).
13. Conduct outside the CAP compound will reflect a positive impression of CAP.
14. Sign In and Sign Out procedures for entering and leaving the CAP compound must be followed.
15. No riding on or in motorized or non-motorized vehicles or aircraft at any time except for official CAP vehicles or aircraft operated by Senior members.
16. No gambling.
17. Any Cadet that brings a personal vehicle to the Encampment **MUST** turn in their vehicle keys.
18. Students must turn in all cell phones and pagers. Cells phones will be available in the evenings if needed.

VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE RULES WILL BE DEALT WITH PROMPTLY AND MAY RESULT IN DISMISSAL FROM THE ACADEMY.

The following items are **PROHIBITED** and **MUST NOT** be brought to the Academy by students. These items **WILL** be confiscated.

Knives

Alcoholic beverages of any kind

Matches, lighters, fire starters, fireworks

Non prescription drugs including over the counter pain relievers

Electronic entertainment devices

Tobacco products of any kind

Questionable reading material

Radios

Food of any kind (candy, chips, etc.)
