

2009 CAP Flight Academy

Application Instructions

Cadets:

Thank you for your support of the 2009 Flight Academy.

The necessary forms, maps and instructions to submit your application are available on the Washington Wing web site <http://wawg.cap.gov/> on the calendar page for July by clicking on any of the Desert Eagle entries. Download and print all of the documents and the WWF23 and WWF24 forms.

Check in will start no earlier than 1200 hours on Wednesday 22 July. The event will end early afternoon on Sunday 2 August. Student's parents are encouraged to attend the graduation ceremony and lunch buffet held Sunday 2 August at 1200.

Cadets must complete the enclosed Washington Wing Forms WWF 23 and WWF 24 and mail these signed forms to Washington Wing. Please indicate on the WWF 23 whether you are applying for power, glider or staff. The forms must be signed by a parent or guardian and your doctor if necessary. Incomplete forms will be returned and will delay the application process.

The fees for students are \$825 for glider and \$900 for power.

The forms and a check payable to Washington Wing CAP for the refundable deposit of \$200 for glider and power students must be received at Wing by 1 June 2009. The fee for staff is \$85.

Power students must provide a copy of proof of US citizenship in the package mailed to Wing. The original birth certificate or equivalent must be presented to the Flight Academy at check in. If you are not a US citizen you must have registered with the TSA and be approved for flight training and have proof that you are registered.

Leave the emergency contact phone list on page 3 with your parents or guardian.

Keep the remainder of the paperwork and bring it with you to the event.

The Code of Conduct form must be signed and turned in at check in.

The student selection process will occur on or about 8 June. Those selected will receive an acceptance letter. The students that are selected will be required to submit an additional check to Wing for the balance due by 24 June. If we have more applicants than we can accept, those who are not selected as students will also be notified and may choose to apply to attend as staff.

Driving directions and maps are included on the web site.

Refer to the list of items to determine what to and not to bring. There will be very limited opportunities to buy any uniform items during the event. You must come prepared for 13 day stay. There is a clothes washer and dryer at the facility.

You must present your CAP ID card and CAPF 101 qualifications card if you have one at sign in. If you have a ROA card present that also.

If anyone plans to stay at a motel in the area instead of in the barracks contact the Project Officer for a list of local motels. The motels are usually full in July so make your reservations early

Seniors must complete the enclosed Washington Wing Forms WWF 24 and WWF 27 and mail these signed forms to Washington Wing. Please indicate on the WWF 27 any preference for duty assignments. Incomplete forms will be returned and will delay the application process.

The forms and a check payable to Washington Wing CAP for \$85 must be received at Wing by 1 June 2009. The staff fee will be prorated for those that are unable to attend the full time.

Leave the emergency contact phone list on page 3 with your family.

Keep the remainder of the paperwork and bring it with you to the event.

The Code of Conduct form must be signed and turned in at check in.

Driving directions and maps are included on the web site.
